

Lenient Treatment of Captives

Principles for the lenient treatment of captives

- Do not hit, swear at, kill or maltreat captives.
- Do not search captives' pockets.
- Give medical treatment to wounded captives.
- Let captives stay or set them free at their own will.

These rules were later developed into Five Policies for Lenient Treatment of Captives:

- Do not kill or injure captives.
- Do not hit, swear at, maltreat or insult captives.
- Do not confiscate the private property of captives.
- Give medical treatment to sick and wounded captives.
- Set the captives free.
